Overview of the role

Role responsibilities

The Estimator/Surveyor is responsible for the implementation of commercial policies and procedures for commercial activities, as well as supporting the business units with contract, project finance and risk management.

- Identify and convert new business opportunities
- Build and maintain key relationships with customers, providing high levels of customer service

- Support with market intelligence gathering to inform and develop business unit strategy and planning along with other members of the business unit team
